As a Cary Academy student, Athlete, Girl Scout and 2019 Miss Teen World America, I am very passionate about this service project, SKRUB, because I designed it myself and began my charity efforts on Thanksgiving 2013. I became passionate about this service project because I wanted to help the homeless people that I saw every day on the side of the road asking for assistance and those I met at the homeless shelters. As a child, I had many conversations with my parents about the pros and cons of delivering survival kits and what supplies to include in them. Today, as a young adult, I do understand that some kits may not be appreciated or may be used for the wrong reasons, so I developed a list and a plan to make it work. My goal and aspirations are to help people that really need it. **"No act of kindness, no matter how small, is ever wasted" – Aesop.**

If these kits only helped ONE person than it was worth all my time and efforts.

I have put a list of items together below that I believe are some items they will need and cannot be used for the wrong reasons. Through the years I have distributed 100 kits yearly to family, friends and neighbors to help share the SKRUB kits to those in need. Any remaining kits I delivered personally at the local homeless shelters.

I have asked local businesses, vendors, family, friends, neighbors and acquaintances for donations of any of the items on the list below or provide gift cards so supplies can be purchased to make the SKRUB kits.

Items for SKRUB kits (male and female kits)

- 1) 100 Drawstring bags to hold the kit items (from Under-Armour) *** This has already been donated ***
- 2) Gift cards from stores (so I can shop for items)
- 3) Wisps to brush teeth without water
- 4) Bottled water, Nabs/snacks that stay fresh longest
- 5) Notebooks, Pencils, pens
- 6) First aid kits (will make - Band-Aids, Antiseptic wipes, Ziplock bags (sandwich size and snack size), etc.)
- 7) individual hand sanitizer packets, Wipes, Tissues
- 8) Combs / brushes
- 9) Feminine items
- 10) Travel size shampoo, conditioner, soap, shower wash, lotion, etc.
- 11) Stationary
- 12) Cheap flashlights
- 13) Waterless shampoo and conditioner
- 14) Gloves, socks, hats, scarves for cold weather
